Please remember to send your child to nursery with spare clothes. Accidents can happen even if they are toilet trained. Their clothes may get dirty from messy play or even eating dinner. Please make sure that all clothing, lunch boxes, bottles, bags and coats coming to nursery are very clearly labelled. Having your child's items labelled clearly will prevent the mix up of coats and bags at home time.

The children having their own belongings labelled encourages them to recognise their own name, differentiate their things from their friends and helps them to become responsible for things that belong to them.

Hot weather and outdoor play

The outdoor environment is a rich, dynamic and natural space for learning and development in children of all ages and every child has a right to daily outdoor learning. Therefore, as summer approaches, we would like to request that you ensure your child is wearing suitable clothing and sun hats. Also, could you provide sun cream (unopened) which we will apply to safeguard the children from becoming sun burnt whilst enjoying the outdoors. The children will be having outdoor play throughout the year, so please remember **'THERES NO SUCH THING AS BAD WEATHER, ITS BAD CLOTHING'**.
